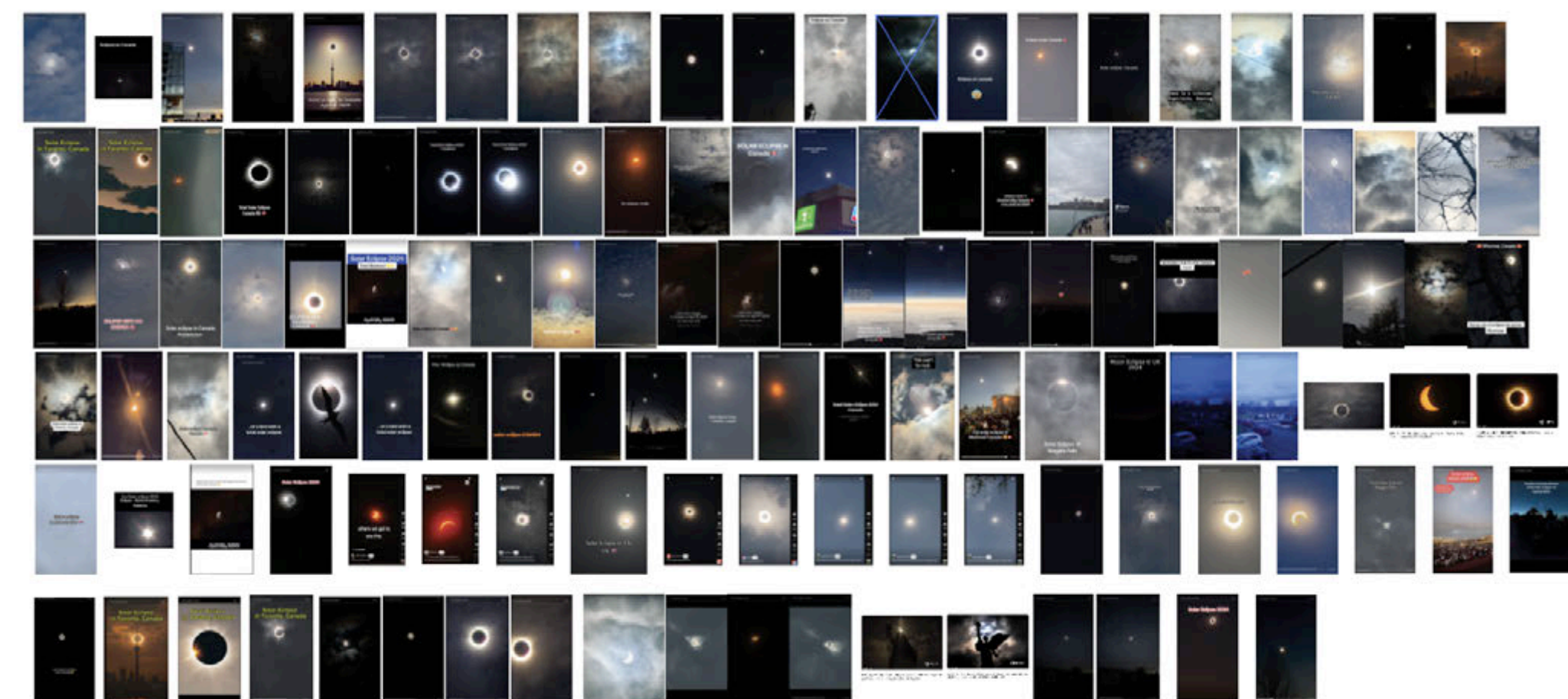
our way of obtaining information in social network is similar to the combination of multi-take cuts and cross-cuts in cinematic language

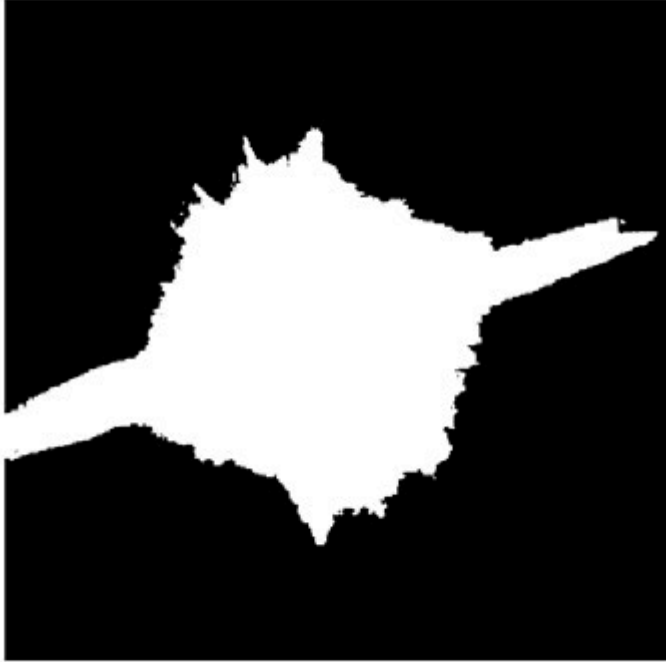
An editing technique in which the exact same action is filmed from various angles all around the subject, then edited together with Jump Cuts amongst all the different angles.

A fragmented presentation of the same event by different people

A film editing technique that involves switching between scenes, making it seem like the action in different locations is happening at the same time. It's also known as parallel editing.

Know several things at same time alternately





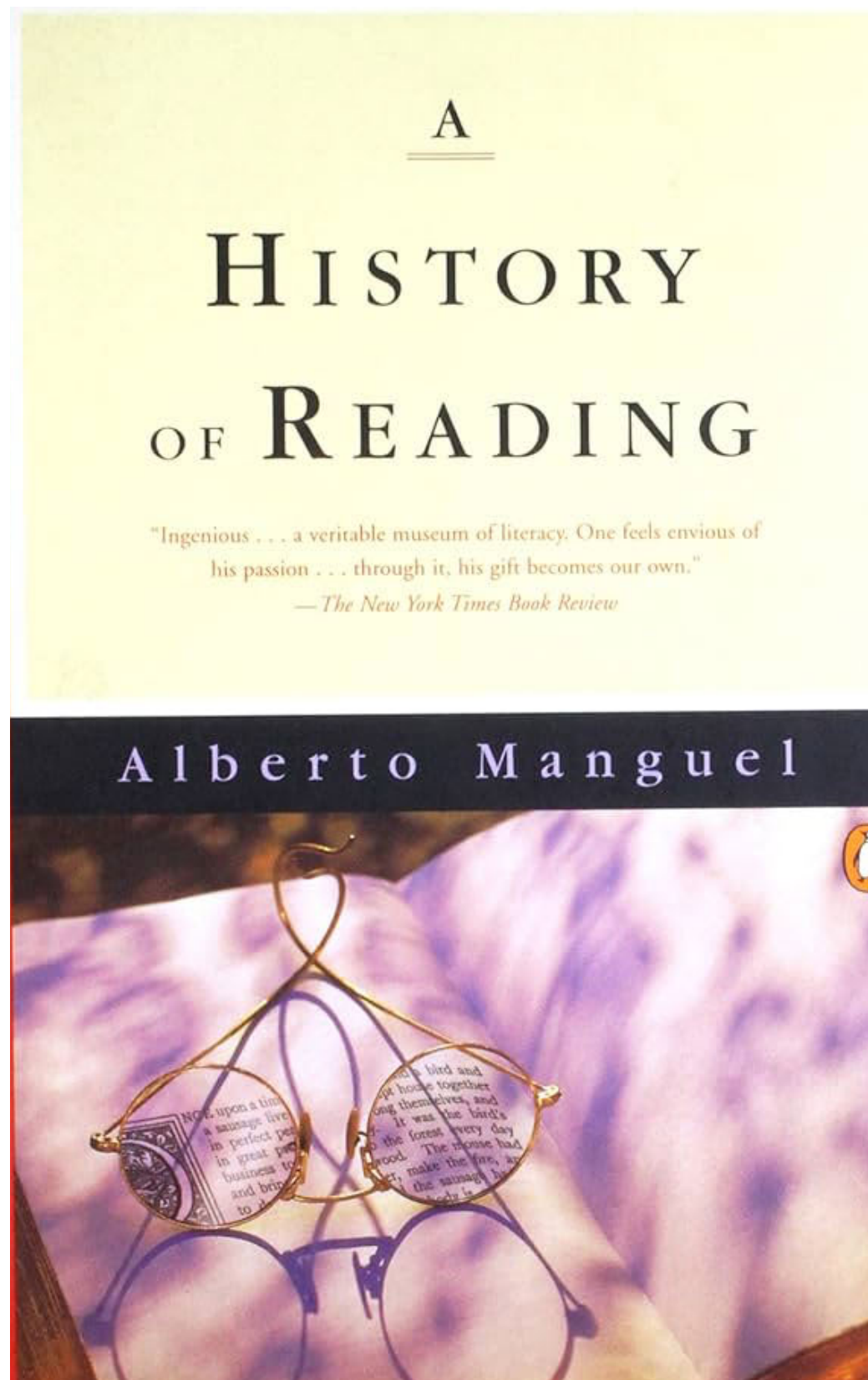

A History of Reading

information exchange process: production, transmission, reception, storage, repetition

Production: The massive amount of information vying for people's limited attention leads content producers to select highlights, concise narratives, and sensational headlines as output content.

Transmission: The rapidity of the internet almost renders transmission time negligible, and all information facts arrive, giving people the illusion that all events are happening simultaneously (in reality, we do not see all events happening at the same time, but we think they are).

Reception: The convenience of devices such as smartphones and computers makes reception common and convenient. We can receive information from various sources anytime, anywhere.

Storage: When storing received information in the brain, due to the characteristics of the production, transmission, and reception processes, we tend to piece together fragmented information into relatively complete narratives and then remember them.

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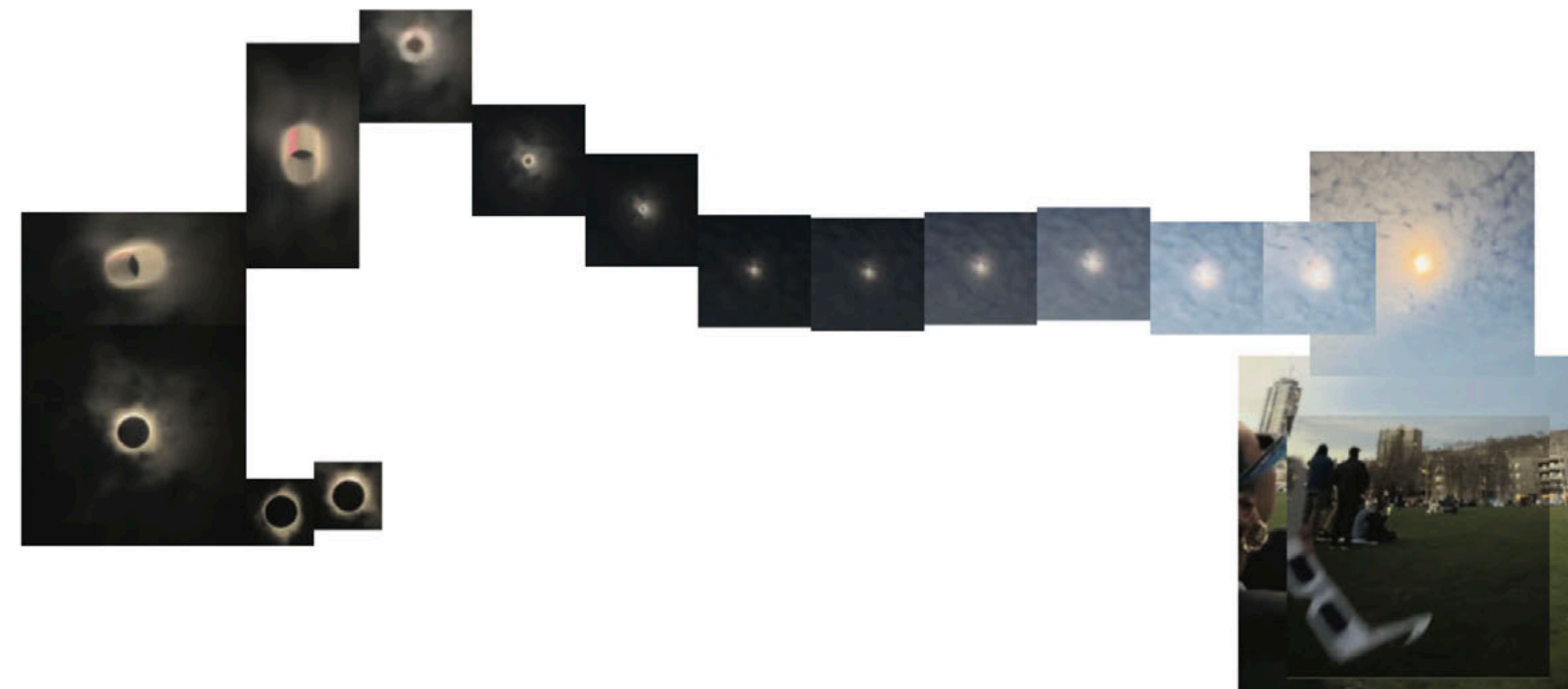

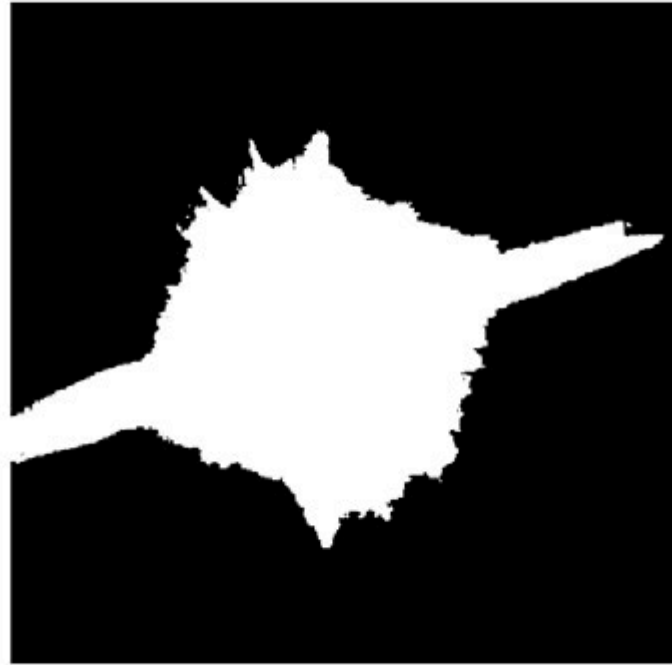
I edited together clips of solar eclipses recorded from different perspectives by different users, simulating fragmented input and patchwork output.

I also misleadingly used elements in the videos unrelated to the eclipse to create a false eclipse process, simulating misunderstood understanding.

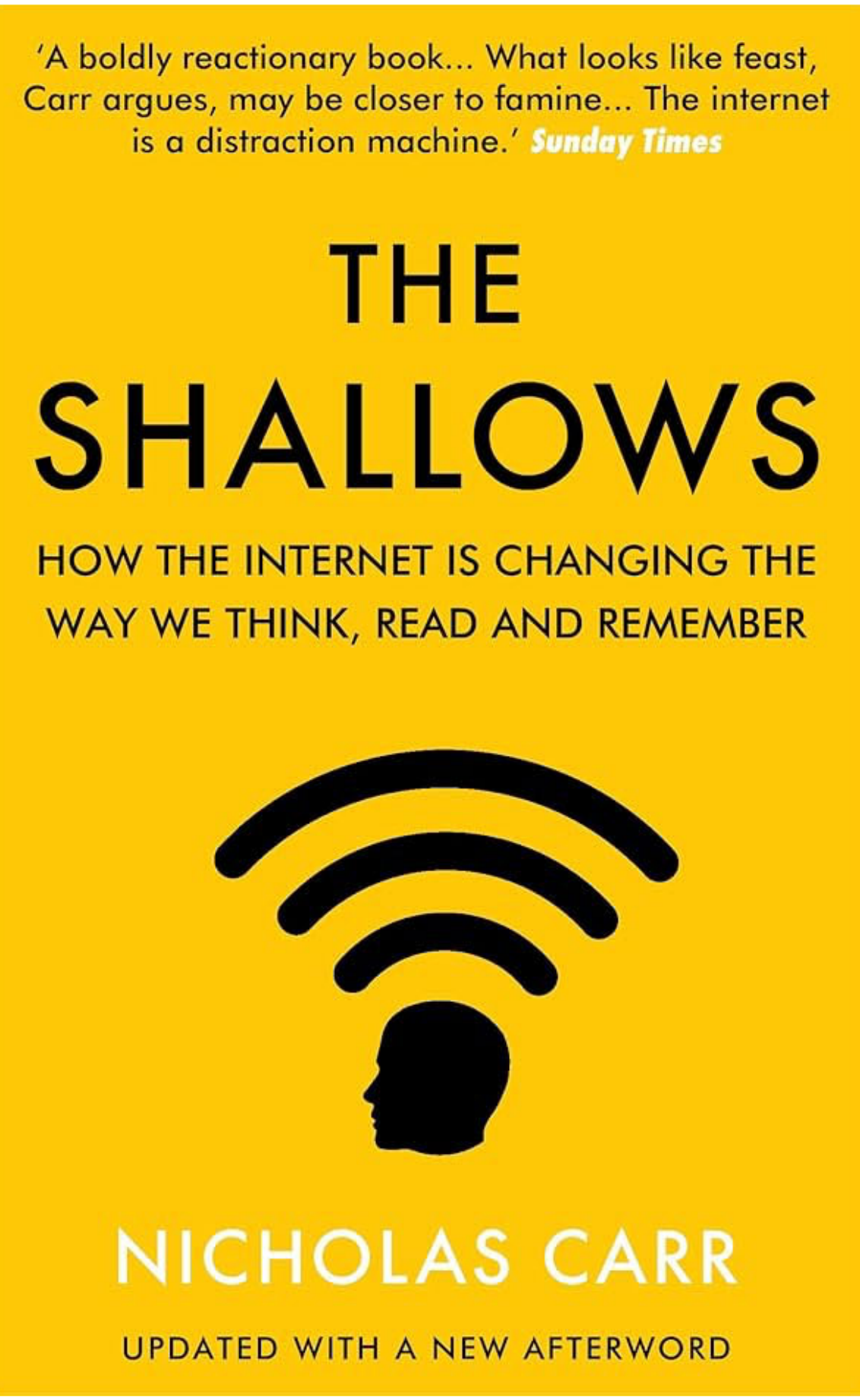

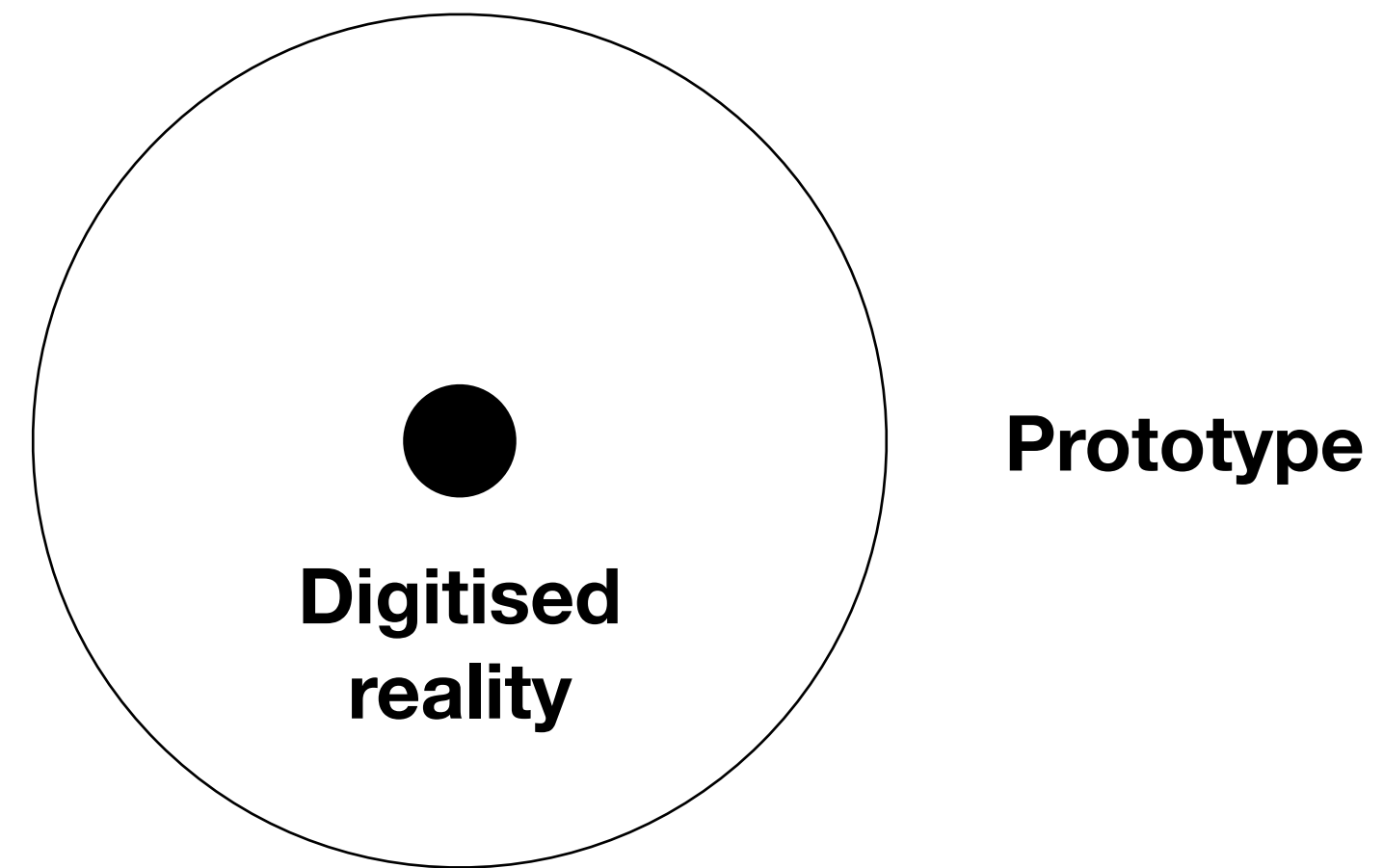


The Shallows

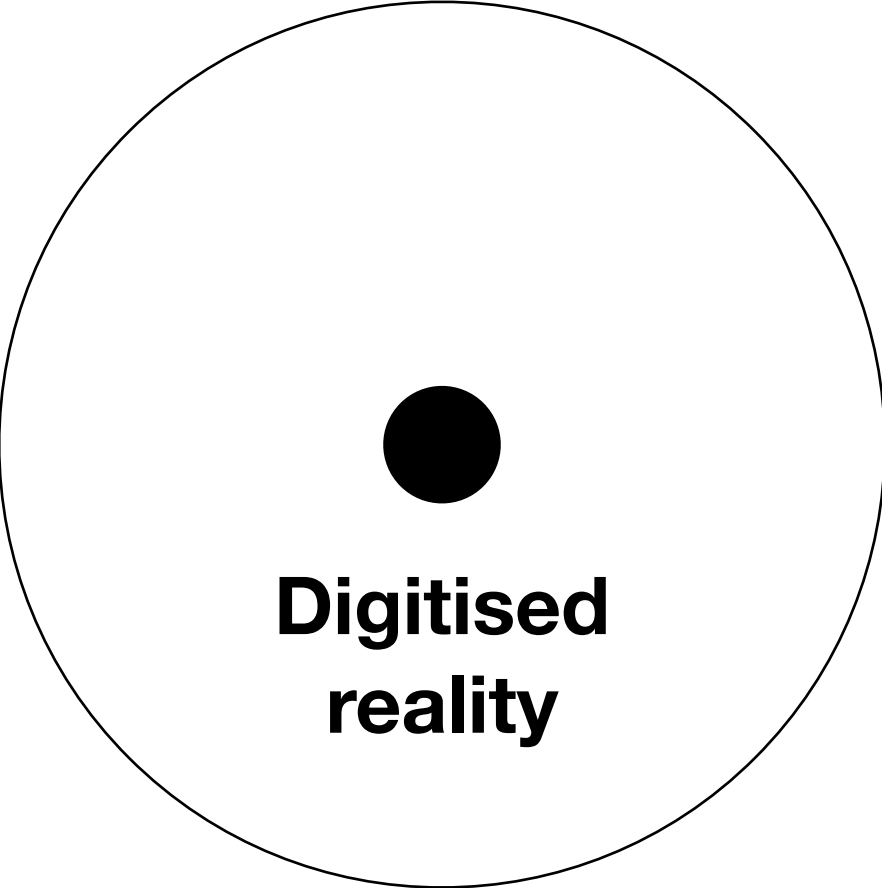
clocks: uniformity, regularity, cyclic repetition;

- c. The prototype should simplify and visually represent complex, abstract logic.

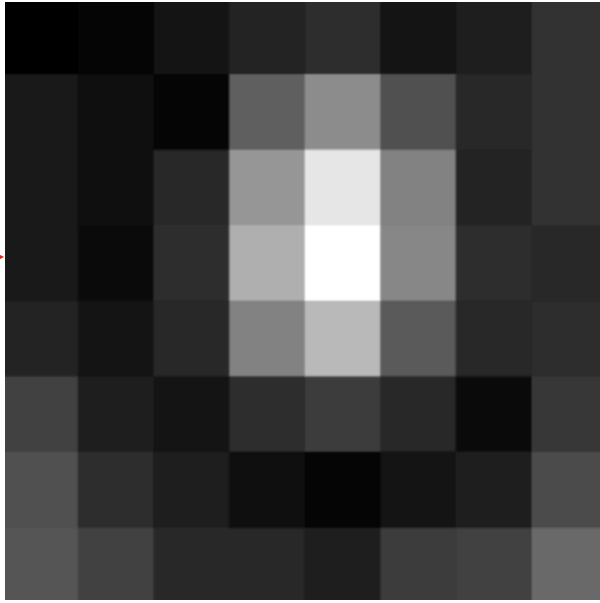

A solar eclipse occurs because part of the sunlight is blocked by the moon. If you are in the shadow of the moon, then you can see the eclipse.

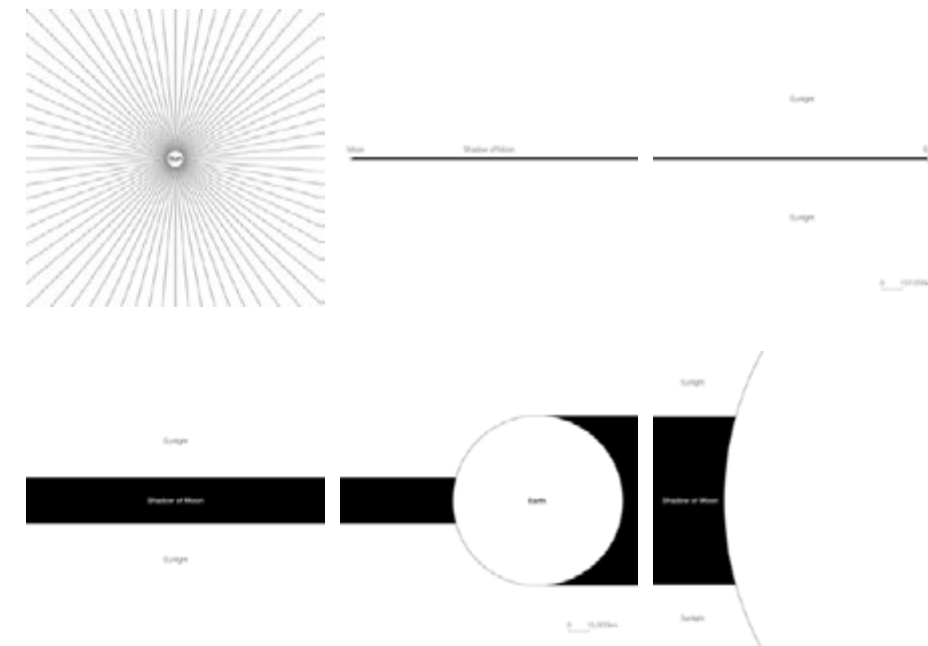


Solar eclipse by phone:
A solar eclipse occurs because part of the sunlight is blocked by a mobile phone. If you are in the shadow of the mobile phone, then you can see the eclipse.



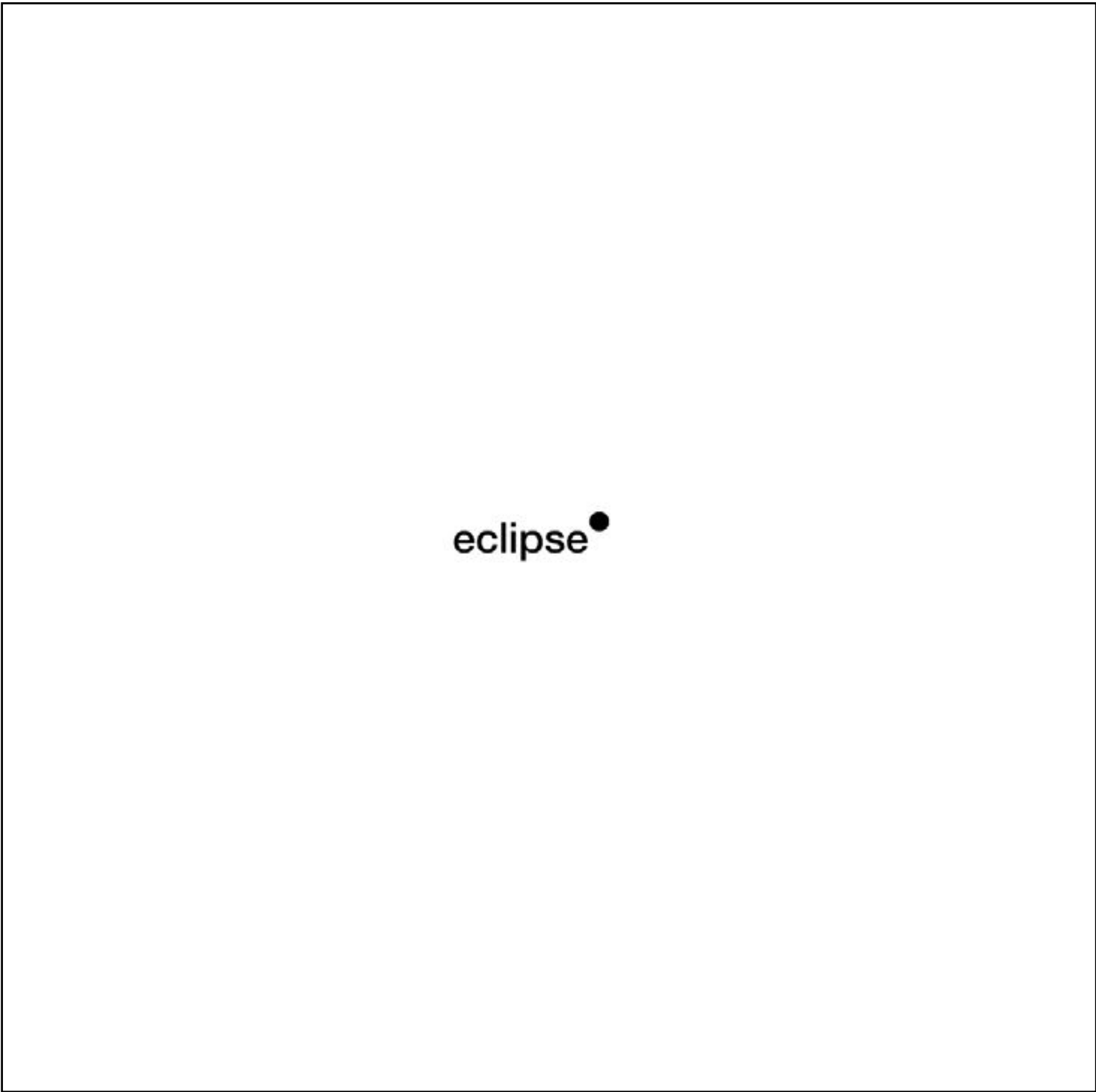
Reality eclipse by digitisation:

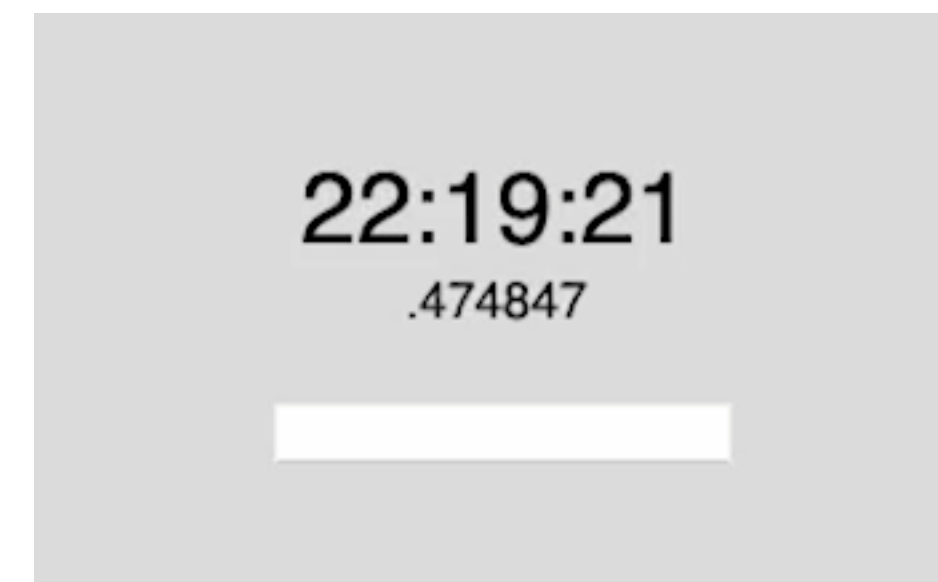


How Computer Networks Became Social

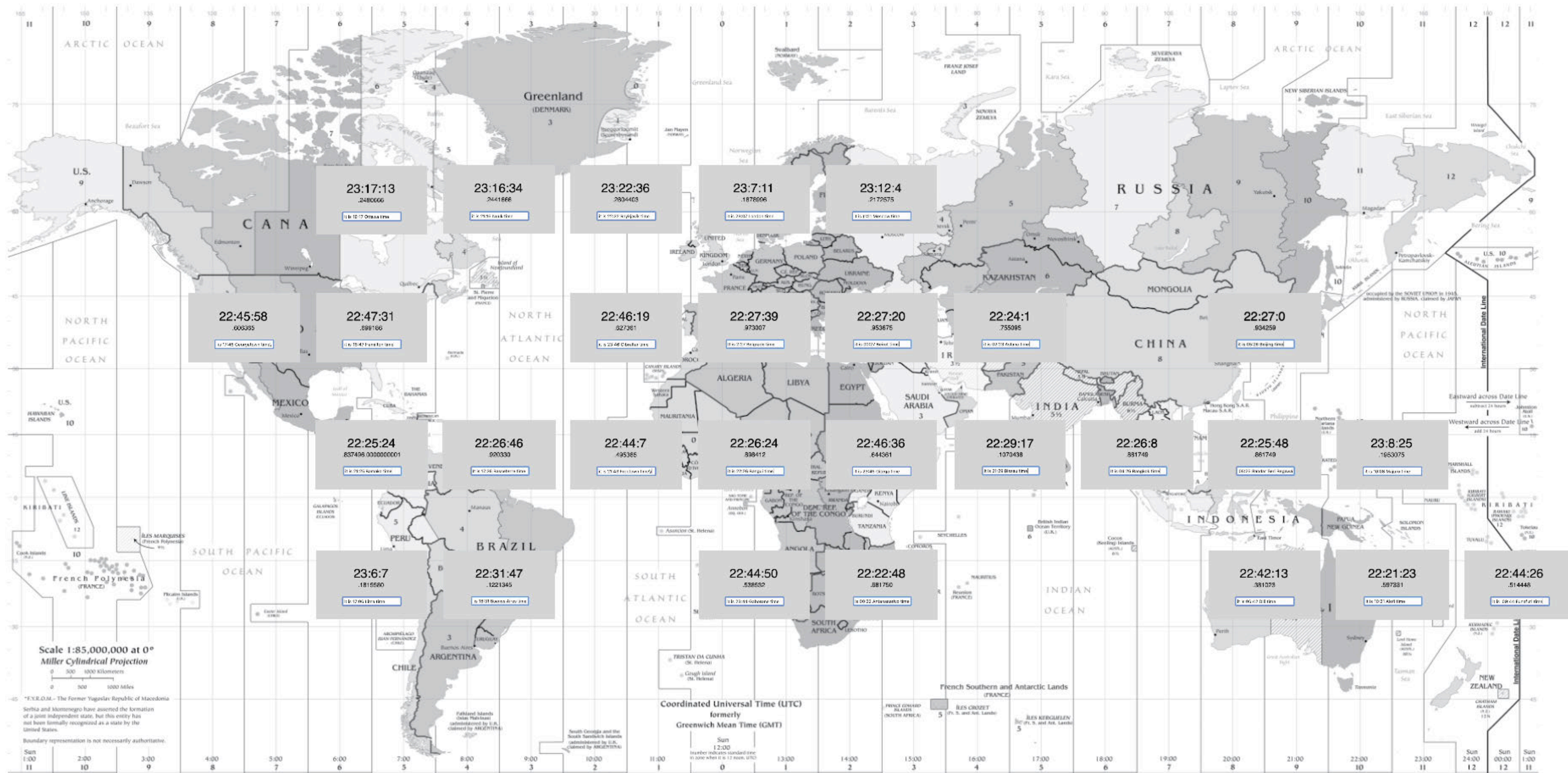




The digitized relationship removes all unclear boundaries,

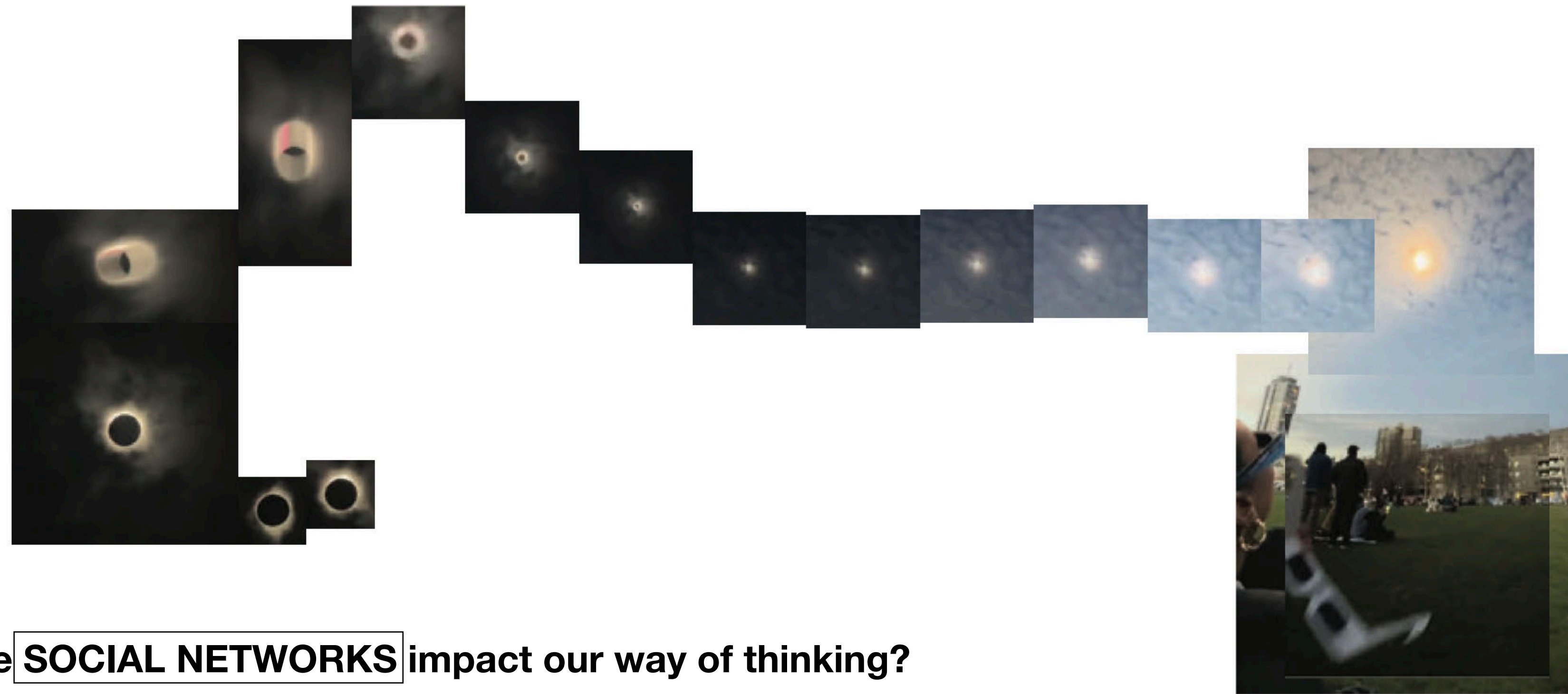
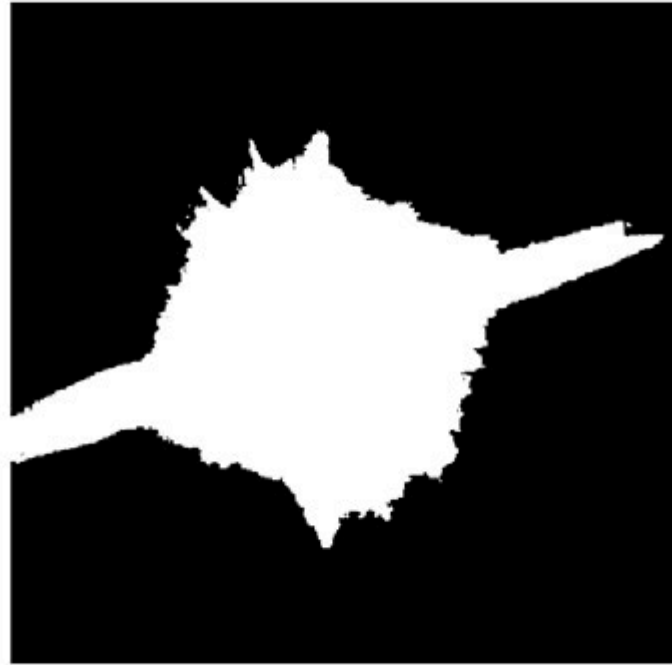

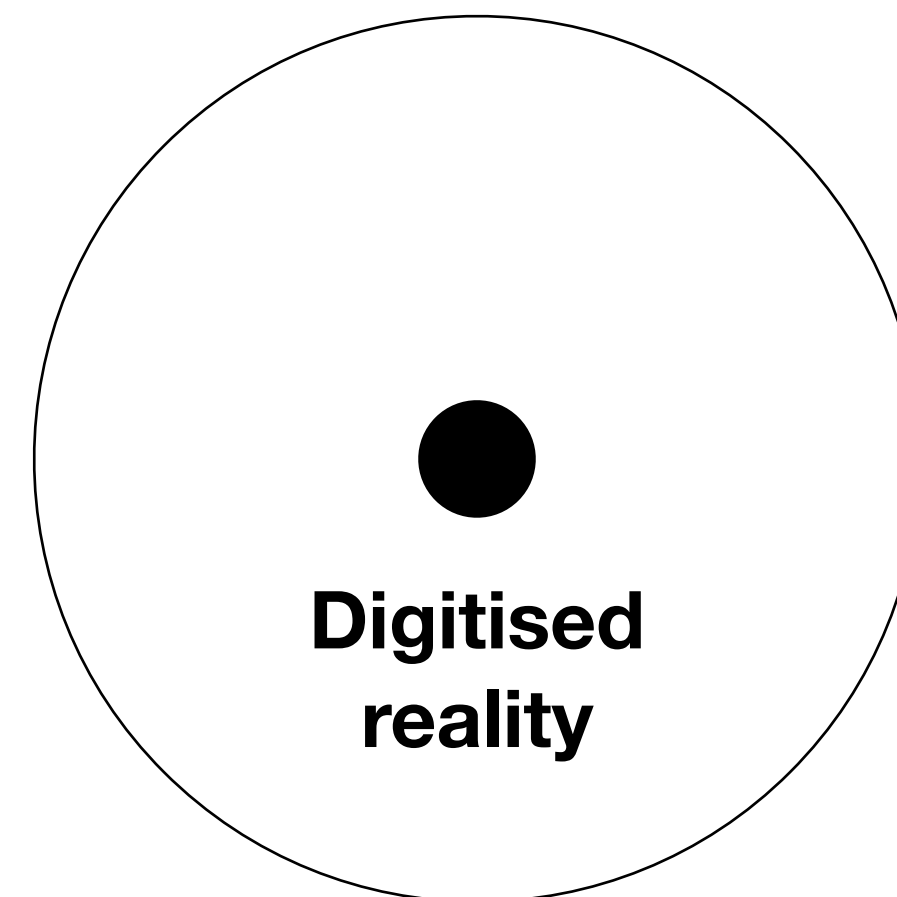
